

Night-Night Kisses



From 3 to 6 years old



2 players (1 player, 1 leader)



Contents: 32 cards, 2 characters, 1 bed



Aim of the game: The idea is to collect as many cards as possible before getting the following 3 cards: "sheet", "pillow" and "lovey blanket".



Game rules: The player empties the box entirely and puts one of the 2 characters (according to preference) on the bed in the box, with the awake "eyes open" side showing. The other character should be put aside.

The game leader shuffles the cards thoroughly and gives the pile to the player, with the pile facing downwards.

The player turns the cards over one by one in front of him.

The cards he turns over represent so many kisses, songs and tickles he will enjoy later. But beware! Every time he turns a "sun" card over, he must remove 1, 2 or 3 cards from his pile (according to the number of suns on the card). The "sun" cards and the removed cards must also be put aside.

When the player draws a "pillow" card, he must place it under the character's head on the bed. The "sheet" card must be placed over the character's legs and the "lovely blanket" card must be placed next to the character or on top of his sheet.

As soon as these 3 cards have been gathered together the game ends. The player gives the leader all the cards he has drawn. The leader turns them over one by one and gives whatever kisses or tickles or sings songs according to what is mentioned on the cards (see card index). When the entire pile of cards has been used up, say goodnight to the character before turning him over (to show his sleeping "eyes closed" side) to go to sleep. Night-night!
